Outcome 5: Children are effective communicators
Specific outcome: children listen actively

in swing

Oh mis-ter sun, sun, mis-ter gol-den sun, please come shine on me, oh mis-ter
 sun, sun, mis-ter gol-den sun, hi-ding be-hind the tree; these li-ttle child-ren are...
 as-king you, to please come out so we can play with you oh mis-ter
 sun, sun, mis-ter gol-den sun, please come shine on me.

Other verses

Oh Mister wind, wind, Mister blowing wind, please come blow on me...

Oh Mister cloud, cloud, Mister puffy cloud, please come rain on me...

Activity

Instrumental play: triangles, finger cymbals, rhythm sticks or eggs



Have children listen and play their instrument after the word "sun" is sung each time.

Extension

- Play different instruments on different verses, for example, the drum could be used for wind, bells for cloud, and so forth.
- Be silly with the kids and have them listen VERY carefully in case you throw in a silly word instead of "sun". For example, you might sing, "Oh Mister watermelon" or another funny word - their challenge is to listen and ONLY respond when you say "sun".
